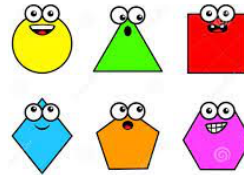
## Make a puppet!

Gather various objects from around the house. Hold out your hands and place one item in each hand. Which item is heaviest and lightest? Can you put them in order from lightest to heaviest.



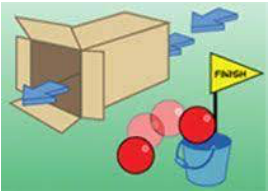
## Reading den!
