

Class 1 Homework Summer 1

This year your homework will be in Pick 'N' Mix format. The red activities at the top need to be completed weekly. The green activities are linked to this half term's topic - 'The Great Outdoors'. Children should choose **at least 5** of the green tasks they would like to complete over the half term. They can be completed in homework books or brought into school on Fridays if they are not in the books. Children will have the opportunity to share their homework tasks with the rest of the class on Fridays.

Read at least 3 times per week. Discuss what you have read with an adult by answering questions, retelling the story or recalling some of the information facts in non-fiction books. Please log in your child's reading journal each time they read.	Use Mathletics to practise the key maths skills we have been learning in class. www.mathletics.co.uk Y1 - practise place value within 100.	Practise your spellings each week ready for our spelling test on Friday.
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Build a den Outside. Take a picture and bring it in to show the rest of the class.	Use some junk to create a bug hotel to attract bugs into your garden.	Make a treasure hunt and set it up for a family member or friend in your garden.
Go on a bug hunt around or garden or local park. Draw some of the bugs you saw.	Use some nature objects and arrange them to make numbers. What number can you go up too? You could use sticks, leaves, stones, flowers...	Design a tent for a teddy that will keep them dry if they went camping outside.
Have a teddy bears' picnic. Have lunch or a snack outside - don't forget to invite the teddy bears!	Plant some vegetables in your garden and watch them grow. What meals could you include them in?	Investigate shadows: create shadows with toys or draw around someone else's shadow. You could use chalk or pencil and paper.
